
PROPOSED GTI LOCATION - VACANT SINCE 2002

Income Growth

Median Household Income Grew 11.5% in 2017

- Compared to 1.8% US Average
- More than **TRIPLE** Florida Average

Per Capita Income Grew 2.4% in 2016

- 50% faster than US Average
- More than **DOUBLE** Florida Average

Employment

- 3.4% Current Unemployment Rate
- 3.1% increase in private sector employment over the last year (DOUBLE the state average-2019)
- Ocala MSA annual job growth rate is **#2 in FL** and **Top 15 Metros** nationally (2018).
 - Among the Florida growth leaders in **Healthcare, Manufacturing**, and **Professional Services**.
- The Ocala MSA is predicted to be **#1 in Personal Income Growth**, **#3 in Job** and **Average Wage Growth** over the next three for all Florida metros.
